- The PPPH describes the publication of a book, in either electronic or print form, as "launching the work into oblivion". Typically, there is no response of any kind. One understands that theoretically there may be metaphysical value in both the execution of the creative act and the reception of the product resulting from the act. However, the PPPH focuses almost exclusively on the first component.
- The staff of the PPPH is not only small but wholly unsuited, from a philosophical
  point of view, to the commercial enterprise associated with the book publishing
  industry. Almost no effort is expended toward marketing and promotion. Our
  budget for all activities is measured not in dollars but in minutes.
